

NANCY O'ROURKE TANG SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION FOR THE 2005-2006 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Nancy O'Rourke Tang Scholarship Fund was established to provide financial support to students in Portland State University's School of Business Administration. The scholarships will be awarded to returning students at the junior-level or beyond who are working toward a four-year accounting degree, a post-baccalaureate accounting certificate, and/or a master's degree with an accounting concentration.

Who Can Apply: Returning students who have had a significant break in their education and are now returning to school. The scholarship is available to both males and females but is restricted to returning students. Special attention may be given to single parent applicants. Both full-time and part-time students are eligible to apply. Recipients of the Nancy O'Rourke Tang Scholarship are eligible to apply in succeeding years.

How to Apply: Complete the application form. If you are an undergraduate student, your application should be accompanied by official transcripts (photocopies accepted) for only those college and/or university credits you have yet to transfer into PSU. If you are a post-baccalaureate student or a graduate student, attached official transcripts (photocopies accepted) from each college and/or university (except PSU) attended after high school. **Two complete sets (application and supporting documents) must be submitted to SBA 240 no later than March 1, 2005.** Send the completed application packet to Portland State University, School of Business Administration, Attn: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 751, Portland, OR 97207-0751.

How Recipients are Selected: Selection will be made by the Nancy O'Rourke Tang Scholarship Selection Committee which may include representatives from the School of Business Administration and non-PSU persons. If there are large numbers of applicants pre-selection may be made by the Scholarship Committee of the School of Business Administration. Awards will be announced in May.

Amount of Scholarship: The number of scholarships and the amounts will be based on income earned by the endowment. It is expected that each year the total amount to be awarded will be stated but the individual amounts and the number of scholarships will be determined by the Committee. It is important that each applicant furnish clear and complete information to the Committee to aid the decision process. It will not be possible to state an amount at this time for the scholarship since the endowment is growing each day. That information will be available when the Committee meets.
